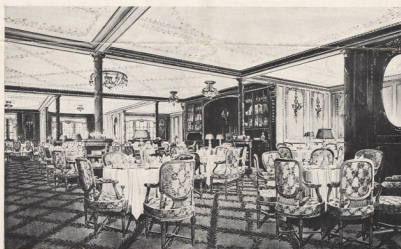

LOUIS XVI. À LA CARTE RESTAURANT.

RESTAURANT.—In addition to the Regular Dining Saloon there is a large modern à la carte Restaurant, with Reception Room on Deck B, where meals may be obtained at any time between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m. at fixed charges, as shown on the bill of fare issued from day to day.

The Restaurant is under the Management of the Company.

If the passage is taken entirely without meals in the regular Dining Saloon, an allowance of £3 per adult will be made off the ocean rate, excepting that on rates of £35 per adult and upwards the allowance will be £5 per adult.

This reduction in fare, however, can only be granted when passengers announce their intention to book without meals, and of making use of the Restaurant, at the time of purchasing their ticket, and no rebate or reduction can be ensured under any other circumstances.

Passengers wishing to use the Restaurant should apply on board to the Manager for the reservation of seats.

Café Parisien.—Adjoining the Restaurant and with large windows overlooking the sea, is a charmingly decorated Café, where meals and light refreshments may be obtained at fixed charges.

The Café Parisien will be open between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m., and is also, as in the case of the Restaurant, under the Company's management.
